Bridge Communities is grateful recipient of \$200,000 from HJWC

The Hinsdale Junior Woman's Club hosted its year-end "It's a Wrap" event on May 8. The group awarded Bridge Communities, this year's charity beneficiary, \$200,000 raised from proceeds at its winter benefit gala. Bridge Communities is a local nonprofit organization that helps homeless families in DuPage County attain self-sufficiency.

In addition to raising money, each club member participates in a service project over the course of the club year. This year's projects ranged from members taking family portraits of Bridge families to participating in "Sleep Out Saturday" to hosting a spa night for parents in the Bridge program.

HJWC raised an additional \$18,000 through its Repeat Boutique and Walking for Causes events. Those funds will be given to 18 different non-profits in the community, all of which were nominated by HJWC members.
